Peer Relationships	In the past month, hung around with people who used drugs or got drunk regularly?	50%	17%
Sexual Behavior	Had sex when you were high or drunk? (past month)	50%	29%
Family/Household Member Relations	Do you have your own personal space?	100%	91%
Legal Issues	Currently awaiting charges, trial or sentencing?	9%	8%
Mental Health	...had significant periods where you felt sad, hopeless, "bummed out" or cried a lot?	73%	50%
